CHICAGO – On Tuesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, Governor Rod R. Blagojevich will join Illinois Department of Veterans' Affairs (IDVA) Director Tammy Duckworth, Illinois Healthcare and Family Services Director Barry Maram, Major General William Enyart, Dr. Felise Zollman, and local veterans to launch the Illinois Warrior Assistance Program at the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago. The Illinois Warrior Assistance Program is a first in the nation program that will screen returning Illinois National Guard members for a traumatic brain injury (TBI) while offering TBI screening to all Illinois veterans, and a 24-hour toll-free psychological helpline for veterans suffering from symptoms associated with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).
